- **Situation:**
 - Set in the Alien franchise universe
 - Takes place at Sevastopol Station
 - Before the events seen in the game Alien: Isolation
 - Audio logs would be spread through the game for the player to find.

- **Characters:**
 - Students
 - Goal is to study microbes found in the gas planet Sevastopol Station orbits for their survival ability and free-floating movement in gaseous environments.
 - Their relationship is purely platonic.
 - **Kerstin Hirsch**
 - 3rd year bioengineering student at Weyland-Yutani Academy
 - 24 year old female
 - Comes from an average family
 - Got into WYA with a fully paid scholarship due to excellent academic performance
 - Takes a careful approach to most situations to try and get everything right in one go.
 - **Kai Conrad**
 - 3d year bioengineering student
 - 25 year old male
 - Come from a rich family of scientists and explorers
 - Got into WYA by family reputation, paid for by the family fortune
 - Can be a bit reckless sometimes to get what he wants
 - Sevastopol
 - Marshals
 - **Marshall Waits**
 - Deputy Ricardo
 - AI
 - APOLLO
 - Main station control AI
 - Directed by Weyland-Yutani to contain and keep the Alien safe.

- **DELPHI**
 - Welcomes visitors and handles most requests
 - Unaffected by Weyland-Yutani directives.
- Aliens
 - Big bad scary and fast. No escape if it spots you.
- **Locations:**
 - **USCSS Beluga**
 - Small commercial transport ship
 - AI piloted, no need for a crew outside of repairs
 - Owned by Kai's uncle
 - Students arrive at Sevastopol via this ship
 - Escape by this ship too
 - Sevastopol Station
 - **Spaceflight Terminal**
 - Anesidora docking bay
 - **Hotel Room**
 - **Shopping Mall**
 - Abandoned shops, closed shops, nothing of interest
 - Meet Marshall Waits here, tells them to go back to their rooms.
 - This is where they hear the noise coming from the:
 - **Ventilation shafts**
 - This is where Kerstin and Kai split up after finding green goo that burns into metal.
 - Kai goes into the shafts to track down the source of the goo.
 - Kerstin waits outside until she hears a horrifying scream.

 - **Elevator/Monorail**
 - **Central Reactor**
 - **The Nest**

Logs:

Log 1: Arrival

Found in the airlock after boarding Sevastopol Station.



Kerstin: Hello? Is this thing even- Ah, there it is. Seems to be on now.

Kerstin: At least there won't be any people in the assistance hotline queue...

DELPHI: Affirmative.

Kerstin: Kai! How long can it possibly take to get our luggage from Baggage Claim?

Kai: *[distant voice]* Wouldn't be taking so long if these damn baggage synths didn't just freeze up while putting it through the xray machine!

DELPHI: I can assist with that.

[conveyor belt revs up]

Kai: Finally!

Kerstin: *[Sighs]* This place will take some getting used to...

Log 3: The Mall

Found in the shopping mall area.



Kerstin: We're not going to find *anything* here, Kai. It's all abandoned. If you wanted some nightlife you shouldn't have come to the ass-end of the galaxy.

Kai: I was just hoping at least one bar would've been open. *One bar!* Is that too much to ask?!

Kerstin: Shush, keep it down. I'm pretty sure we're not supposed to be out this late.

Kai: Well if they didn't want anyone here they would've locked the bulkheads right?

Kerstin: *[Alert, noticing a flashlight shining around a corner] Shhhh!*

Kai: What is-? *[cuts off]*

Marshall Waits: Hello? Anyone here? You really shouldn't be out here at this time.

[Marshall Waits turns the corner and finds Kerstin and Kai]

Marshall Waits: What are you kids doing out here? Why are you out at this hour? Who are you, even? I've not seen you two around the station before.

Kerstin: We're from the Weyland- *[gets cut off]*

Marshall Waits: Finally, I thought you'd never arrive. Aren't you two a little young to be handling this thing?

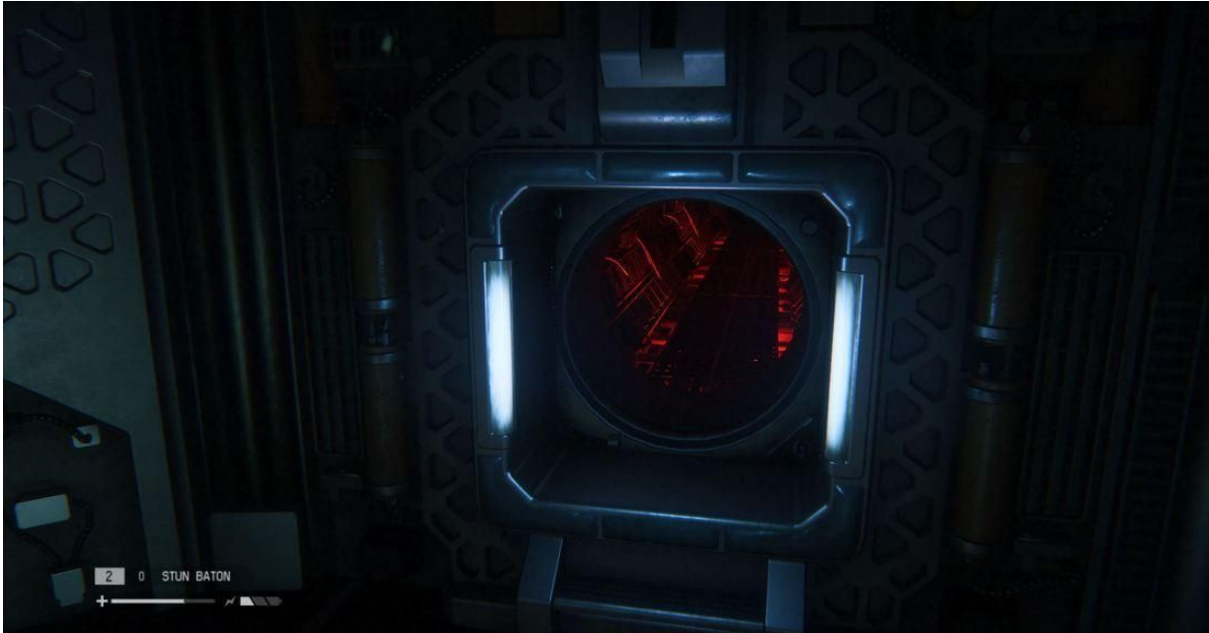
Kai: Too young? Too young for what?

Log 4: Getting caught

Found in the shopping mall area after the previous one.



[Loud banging noise in the distance]

Kerstin: Wait, what was that? That sounded close.

Kai: It looks a bit biological in nature, doesn't really have the viscosity of oil or coolant... Looks like it came out of this vent.

Kai: If it's biological, and it's eating through metal, we should at least get a sample. Find out what it's made off. Maybe even find what left it here.

Kai: Don't be silly, there's no way a rat could've made that. I'm gonna go see what did, though.

Kerstin: In there? Don't be an idiot. If you touch that green stuff you'll get burned too, and we don't even know what it is.

Kai: *[From halfway inside the vent]* I'll be fine, you know I always will be.

Kerstin: Don't expect me to be waiting for you when you get back, though. I'm going back to the rooms.

Kai: *[distorted through the vents]* Don't worry, I'll just call DELPHI for assistance, she's always willing to help me.

[Tape speeds up a bit, forwards to Kerstin walking back to the room]

Kerstin: Why does he always have to be so stupid and go off on these adventures without thinking of the-

[A deep, terrifying scream fills the hallway, coming from the vents]

Kerstin: What the-... Kai?! Kai is that you?!

[tape cuts off]

Log 5: It begins

Found in the railway station.



[3 beeps and a short ringing sound later]

DELPHI: How can I be of assistance today?

Kirsten: [audibly shaken] Can you please locate Kai Conrad for me?

DELPHI: I'm sorry, but I can not find his current location. He may be off-station or moving too fast.

Kirsten: [audibly shaken and upset] Or he might be dead.

DELPHI: Unlikely, his bioscanner still shows a heartbeat. Although it is elevated rather high.

Kirsten: Let me know if you locate him, please. And do not inform the Marshall about this yet. I need to know what's going on before this gets us kicked off the station.

DELPHI: Acknowledged.

Log 6: Mystery

Found in the living quarters.



Kirstin: *[To the recorder]* It has been 2 hours since I heard from Kai, I'm considering informing the Marshall to get a search party together. This study be damned.

[Tape speeds up a bit, forwards to the next section]

[Ringing]

DELPHI: I have located Kai Conrad. I attempted to contact him but he appears non-responsive.

Kirstin: So, where is he?!

DELPHI: He is located inside the central reactor.

Kirstin: How the hell did he get in there?

DELPHI: Unknown.

Kirstin: What is he even doing there?

DELPHI: Unknown.

Kirstin: Is he alright?

DELPHI: His heartbeat is no longer elevated and has slowed down to below average.

Kirstin: What is that even supposed to mean? Where is he? I need to go find him and drag his ass back to the room.

DELPHI: APOLLO won't allow it.

KIRSTIN: APOLLO? The station system AI? Why won't he allow me to get my friend out of his central reactor?

DELPHI: Unknown.

Kirstin: I'll guess I'll have to go and do it myself. Where can I get a crowbar, a flashlight and a first-aid kit?

Log 7: Reveal

Found at the entrance to the central reactor.



Kai: *[dazed and confused]* Wuh-what? Where am I? Why do I feel so hungry?

Kirstin: *[whispering]* Kai! Wake up! I need to get you out of here.

Kai: *[Some tired sleepy mumbling]*

Kirstin: You're covered in some sort of biological glue, but it's set so I can break you out. Brace yourself.

[Crumbling wet noises]

Kai: What is going on?

Kirstin: We are getting the hell out of this space station. I don't know what kind of experiments they've been running here, but I doubt we were sent to study microbes.

DELPHI: I'm reading 5 more heartbeats nearby, moving towards your location.

Kai: Heartbeats? Location, where even are we?

Kirstin: Oh just shut up for once and follow me. Delphi, what's the shortest way to our ship?

Log 8: Epilogue

Found in the ambulance shuttle.



Kai: What THE HELL were those things?!

Kirstin: I have no idea, nor do I even care about finding out. We're out off that tower now, your uncle's ship is at the next one. We're getting out of here as soon as possible.

Kai: With that, I agree. I'm done adventuring for *life*.

[tape stops and fast forwards a second later]

[Kai moaning in pain in the background]

Kirstin: Kai? Kai! What's wrong with you. Why are you shaking so much?

Kirstin: Ship, analyze his vitals!

[Sound of something bursting out of his body as Kai collapses and makes no more sound]

Kirstin: *[screams]*

[A loud thud of something heavy falling on the floor just a split second before the tape abruptly ends]
